



Lighting the Christ Candle: *Linda McKinnon*We light this candle as a symbol of the presences of Christ, known to us through the stories we share, experienced by us through the gathered community, and present to us through the Spirit that is in our midst. (candle is lit)

\*Call to Worship: (responsive) Wendell Gregan, Wayne & Liz Mullin VU #315, vs. 1, 3 & 4 after each reading as indicated) "Holy, Holy, Holy"

L: Welcome to the Trinity Sunday, the beginning of the Season after Pentecost, a season for us to experience Gods' power and majesty and to proclaim Gods' love in witness and action in the world.

**One:** Come stand before God, who comes to us as creator, heavenly parent, hole and mighty one.

**Two**: Come stand in the presence of God and sense God's mystery and creative power in our world. Come and proclaim, "Holy, Holy, Holy God!"

(All sing VU #315, vs. 1 "Holy, Holy, Holy" as the first candle is lit)

One: come stand before God, who comes to us as Jesus, redeemer, friend, Saviour. Come and learn of Gods' free gifts of forgiveness, healing and grace. Come and proclaim, "Holy, Holy, Holy God!" (All sing VU #315, vs. 3, "Holy, Holy, Holy" as the second candle is lit)

**Two**: Come and stand before God, who comes to us as Holy Spirit, sanctifier, comforter. Come and receive the promise of new, strong hearts and hands to do Gods' work in the world. Come and proclaim, "Holy, Holy, Holy God!"

(All sing VU #315 vs. 4, "Holy, Holy," as the third candle is lit)

L: Come let us worship God who breaks into our lives as the holy living three-in-one.

Gathering Prayer: (Unison)

Loving, Gracious, and Surprising Spirit, gather us together. Unify our hearts, minds, and spirits. Send us reminders of your presence so that we never forget to notice. Come to us in a friendly voice that we will recognize. Sing us songs that we know well and others for which the melody is catchy and new. Open our spirits as we journey the well-trodden paths so that we may discover you again as if for the first time. Your love gathers us together, helps relieve us in our grief, our guilt, and our loneliness. Help us to navigate the way forward and to listen for your call. Make this day and this gathering a new beginning for us. Amen.

Let us join in this Litany of Faith: (Unison)
We trust in God the Holy Spirit, everywhere the giver and renewer of life. The Spirit justifies us by grace through faith, sets us free to accept ourselves and to love God and neighbour, and binds us together with all believers in the one body of Christ, the church. The same Spirit who inspired the prophets and apostles rules our faith and life in Christ through Scripture, engages us through the Word proclaimed, claims us in the water of baptism, feeds us with the bread of life and the cup of salvation, and calls women and men to all ministries of the Church. In a broken and fearful world the Spirit gives us courage to pray without ceasing, to witness among all peoples of Christ as Lord and Saviour, to unmask idolatries in church and culture, to hear the voices of peoples long silenced, and to work with others for justice, freedom, and peace. In gratitude to God, empowered by the

Spirit, we strive to serve Christ in our daily tasks and to live holy and joyful lives, even as we watch God's new heaven and new earth, praying, Come, Lord Jesus! With believers in every time and place, we rejoice that nothing in life or in death can separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. Glory be to the Father, and to the Sun, and to the Holy Spirit. Amen.
